
While the version in Optic Clear glass creates sparkeling reflections, the version in Opal White glass completes the minimalistic Nordic look.

Use of a dimmer is highly recommended (Must be compatible with type of bulb.)


The glass used for this lamp is hand-blown.









Mount the back part of the lamp to the wall or ceiling with screws.

Please make sure it is fixated properly.




Carefully place the small metal plate over the socket.




Lead the power cable in through either the bottom or the back of the ceiling plate


Connect the wire-ends to the cable connector. Match the brown wire with "L" the blue wire with "N" and the green/yellow wire with the grounding symbol



Place a G9 light bulb in the socket.



Carefully place the cover plate over the socket.



Take the glass globe and carefully place it over the light bulb. Fixate it by turning the glass globe clockwise.
