DESCRIPTION

Creating an exclamation mark in the interior, the Modern Line Chaise Longue is extended from the original Modern Line Sofa, designed in 1949 by the legendary Greta M. Grossman. Taking the low back and seat as inspiration, the elongated chaise longue invites for serious lounging with maximised enjoyment. The Modern Line Chaise Longue possess an understated elegance and a sense of lightness, which stays true to Grossman's design and vision, and brings life and character to any interior space.

MATERIALS

The Chaise Lounge chair is constructed with a frame of solid pinewood, plywood and precovered chipboard.

No-zak springs are mounted on the seat frame for extra comfort.

Foam characteristics for seat: Main foam HR 40 kg / 150 N. Top layer HR 35 kg $\,$ / 120 N $\,$

Foam characteristics for back: HR 35 kg / 120 N $\,$

Back and seat is covered with fiber watting

The chaise lounge is available in a wide range of fabrics.

Legs Ø13 mm $\,$ // Black - powder coated RAL 9005 / gloss 20-30 $\,$





ACCESSORIES

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

For cleaning the upholstered surface, first try to brush off the dirt gently. If this is not enough then vacuum the surface. If further cleaning of the padding is needed, a stain remover is recommended. The cleaning has to be gentle and must always be tested on the most invisible area of the surface before the actual cleaning. Avoid blotches by gentle, circular rubbing towards the stain.

To avoid stains, quickly remove the dirt with a piece of absorbing household wipe and clean with water and colourless washing-up liquid. Do not use the following products for the padding:

- Undiluted cleaning liquids.
- Bleach.
- Ammoniac.
 Soap for hard surfaces.

For further cleaning guidance, we refer to information regarding the specific textile.
